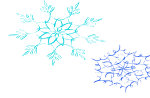

Walnut Hills Trivia

The Colorado Ave. Baptist Church located at 101 Heaton Ave. celebrated its 95th anniversary on October 12, 2008. In 1903, Baptist Union purchased an empty lot in Walnut Hills. Three years later, when the Third Street Baptist Church moved to a new building, the old edifice was dismantled and moved to this lot at Colorado and Heaton Avenues. The building was used for a Sunday school mission of the Linden Ave. Baptist Church until 1913 when the congregation reorganized as the Colorado Ave. Baptist Church. The present building was erected in 1916 while Europe was embroiled in World War I.

On the national front, the presidential election of 1916 pitted incumbent Democratic candidate, President Woodrow Wilson, against Supreme Court Justice Charles Evans Hughes, Republican candidate. After a difficult contest, Wilson defeated Hughes by a narrow margin.

Remember to vote on Election Day! The 2008 presidential election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 4. The Republican Party has chosen John McCain, the senior United States Senator from Arizona as its nominee; the Democratic Party has chosen Barack Obama, the junior United States Senator from Illinois, as its nominee. The Libertarian Party has nominated former Congressman Bob Barr, the Constitution Party has nominated pastor and radio talk show host Chuck Baldwin, and the Green Party has nominated former Congresswoman Cynthia McKinney. Ralph Nader declined to seek the Green Party nomination and is running as an independent candidate.

The Downtown Dayton Partnership has enlisted the help of the Dayton Chapter of the American Institute of Architects for the Strategic Building Reuse Project, which aims to bring new life to nine structures and a streetscape.

Investigate All Investment Opportunities before Making an Investment

The Department of Commerce, Division of Securities is reminding Ohioans to beware of investment ideas that are promising guaranteed high returns on your money. The Division encourages all investors to know their investments goals, know if their financial professional is licensed, and know and understand the investment opportunity.

Before making any investment decisions, investors are urged to call the Division's **Investor Protection Hotline** at **1-800-788-1194** to ask:

- > Is the brokerage firm and salesperson licensed to sell securities in Ohio?
- > Have any enforcement actions been taken against them?
- > Has the investment been properly registered with the Division of Securities?

Investors are encouraged to also request written information about any investment, carefully review it, and ask other professionals to review this information as well. Be cautious if a salesperson tries to force you to make an immediate decision. It is always a good idea to seek additional counsel regarding investments from a Certified Public Accountant and Attorney before making any big investment decisions.
