**Walnut Hills and Dayton Trivia  
November 3, 2009 Election Day**

Dayton was once governed by a seven-member city council headed by a council president. The following gentlemen served as president of the City Council from 1821 to 1828: M. Patton (1821), J.H. Conover (1823), J. Compert (1824), S. Broadwell (1825), E. Brabham (1826) and Dr. J. Steele (1827-1828). Today the Dayton City Commission is comprised of the Mayor and four City Commissioners. Each City Commission member is elected at-large on a non-partisan basis for four-year, over-lapping terms. Remember to get out and vote Tuesday, Nov. 3 to maintain a strong city government.

## Bulk Waste Pick-Up

The City of Dayton provides four bulk-waste pick-ups a year at no cost. **Bulk waste pick-ups must be scheduled in advance by calling 333-4800.** Residents can call between new expanded hours of 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Bulk waste items are to be set out after 3:00 p.m. of the day *before* the scheduled pick-up. City crews begin pick-ups at 7:00 a.m.

### Bulk Waste Guidelines

- You must separate your metal items (stoves, refrigerators, etc.) from other bulk items.
- Remove refrigerator doors.
- All loose and small items must be securely contained, bundled or bagged for easy pickup.
- The City cannot pick up concrete, rocks, brick blocks, sand, gravel, or hazardous waste.
- Yard waste (brush, hedges, tree limbs, etc.) must be tied into bundles not larger than 4 feet long and 18 inches in diameter.
- Bundles are limited to 25 pounds each.
- The City cannot pickup grass clippings.

### Waste Collection Do's and Don'ts:







- ▣ Do have your rollout container or bulk items out by 7:00 a.m.
- ▣ Do keep bulk and metal items separated (they're picked up by a separate truck).
- ▣ Do place the recycling container or any other items at least 5 feet from your rollout container.
- ▣ Do keep yard waste separated from other collection items (it also must be cut and tied in 4-foot lengths no larger than 18 inches in diameter).
- ▣ Do not leave rollout at curb or alley after collection.
- ▣ Do not overfill rollout (lid should be closed on rollout).
- ▣ Do not place any hot items in rollout (e.g., ashes from fireplace).
- ▣ Do not place rollout close to any obstruction (such as an automobile).
- ▣ Do not put loose trash in rollout (wrap or bag all trash).
- ▣ Do not have trash piled on or around rollout.

## 2009 WHNA Leaf Collection Schedule

First Collection Week- **Nov. 16- 20**     
   Second Collection Week- **Dec. 21 – Jan. 1**

The Division of Street Maintenance (DOSM) is going to try and collect leaves twice this year "on every street in each neighborhood." Collection occurs Monday through Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. (excluding holidays). DOSM requests that you have your leaves ready by Monday of the scheduled week. Leaf collection can occur on any day of the collection week. Remember to rake leaves to the gutter at the curb line in front of your residence prior to 7:00 a.m. Monday the week of your scheduled collection. Leaves must be loose in order for leaf collection equipment to operate properly. Bagged leaves may be placed at the curb in front of your residence. Please do not mix grass, twigs, tree trimmings or other yard waste with your leaves. Do not park your car over leaves raked to the curb line any day during the scheduled collection week. **DO NOT** place leaves in the alley, either loose or in bags.
