Look for New U.S. Census Survey in Your Mail Your Response Needed to Attract Funding for Dayton (as reported in Dayton Update)

Dayton residents are asked to be on the lookout for a new survey form that may be mailed to your home by the U.S. Census Bureau.

Although the official U.S. census process occurs once every ten years, the Census Bureau has started a new effort to collect important community information every year. As a result, many residents can expect to receive a form in the mail asking them to answer a number of census-related questions, such as the amount of people in the household, education levels, demographic figures, employment status, etc.

If you receive one of these new census forms, it is very important that you take the time to answer the questions and mail the form back in. You're required by law to respond. Plus, the information you provide helps ensure that the federal government has accurate information about the city of Dayton. Among other benefits, these figures also help determine how much financial support our city receives for roads, schools and other community projects. If you do not return the form, the Census Bureau will continue to send you reminder notices.

The new U.S. Census Bureau form carries the title of "The American Community Survey." If you see this in your mailbox, please do not disregard it!
